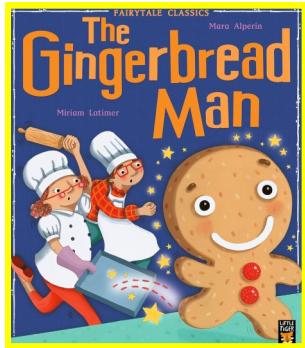

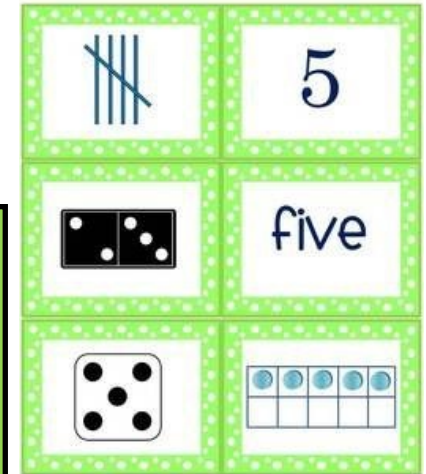

Introduction to PE Unit 1

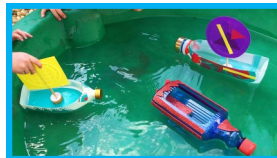
