## Content & Sequencing

Primary PE Passport is used as a tool to teach the Physical Education.

## Cross Curricular Links

Wider curriculum presents lots of opportunity to use skills learned in PE. PSHE lessons can be used to implement healthy lifestyles. Brain breaks can also be used in lessons throughout the Curriculum as well as active Maths, English and Topic lessons.

## Retrieval practice

Recap of prior learning is carried out at the beginning of every PE lesson.

## Progress

Progression of PE skills is evident from KS1 to KS2.

At the end of each lesson and end of unit statements are available for teachers to assess against the lesson outcomes.

Assessment tracker to be completed after each unit of work.

## Support

Children are exposed to the Physical Education curriculum as early as Nursery.

Staff CPD provided by Primary PE Passport and the PE lead to aid staff with the delivery of PE.
